Nature of the Position

The teaching position reports to the Academic Dean's office and to the new Social Work Technology Department. The role of the teacher will be to instruct the first cohort of DEC college-level students in the concepts and competencies related to the program, in accordance with the objectives of each course. As the department is being created, teachers will also have the opportunity to participate in the launch of the program, contribute to the development of the courses, and support the continuous improvement of the program.

Summary of Duties

The teacher will be expected to contribute to the development of the program and will be responsible for preparing courses, developing teaching materials for each course, delivering instruction, preparing assessments, and grading them in accordance with the objectives of the course outline.

Qualifications

- Bachelor's degree in Social Work.
- Minimum of 5 years of professional experience in the field.
- Excellent command of French or English (both spoken and written), depending on the language of the course.
- Comfortable communicating in French and working in a mainly French-speaking environment.
- Ability to organize and plan work efficiently and methodically within reasonable timeframes;
- Ability to build healthy working relationships and to work collaboratively.
- Ethical and professional conduct.
- Knowledge of computer tools and generative artificial intelligence (GenAI).
- Experience in training or teaching is an asset.
- Membership in good standing with the Ordre des travailleurs sociaux et des thérapeutes conjugaux et familiaux du Québec (OTSTCFQ) is an asset.
- Significant professional experience in various intervention settings, particularly in communities, institutional, or private practice settings, is an asset.
